



Click the button on the top right-hand corner Go to Tools -> Extensions



In the Extensions page, click the "Get more extensions" link This will open up the Chrome Web Store



On the left hand side search bar, search "ie tab"




Find under Extensions (not Apps) IE Tab You do not have to pay for this extension!

When you see this icon appear on the top right-hand corner, it is ready. Click the icon


Frequently Asked



It will install the first time you click it Click the "ietabhelper.exe"



You'll now see a second URL address bar under the Chrome address bar. Use this to access sites that Chrome cannot access
